Amelia Inez Wolf known as Emily or Aunt Mellie to her many nieces and nephews passed away at the age of 85 on Feb. 25, 2026. Born in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma on Sept.26, 1940 to Guadalupe and Manuel Diaz as the youngest of eight children. Emily was raised in the shadow of Little Flower Church where her father worked in the print shop for the Carmelite fathers. The close-knit neighborhood and the church fostered lifelong friendships and a strong devotion to the Catholic faith. Emily attended St. Mary's High school where she was a cheerleader, enjoyed attending football games and the Friday night sock-hops.
