Arthur "Clay" Comer was born on August 20, 1947 in Enid, Oklahoma to E.S. and Roberta (Bedell) Comer, and passed away suddenly on August 8, 2021.

Clay graduated from Enid High School in 1965 and attended college at Oklahoma State University Institute of Technology in Okmulgee. Clay met his "beautiful bride", Betty Dysart, in June 1974 and they were then married in St. Francis Xavier Catholic Church on December 14, 1974. Clay was an active member of St. Gregory's Catholic Church of Enid as well as a member of the Blue Lodge (Garfield Lodge 501, Coronado 56, Enid 80) and honorably served as the Grand Chaplin for the State of Oklahoma Grand Lodge in 1999. Clay was well known for the "colorful" stories he told, as a friend to many, and his ability to talk to ANYONE, Everywhere! Clay was also a member of the Guthrie Valley Scottish Rite, a friendly Shrine clown named "Zeke", and earned his 33rd Degree.
