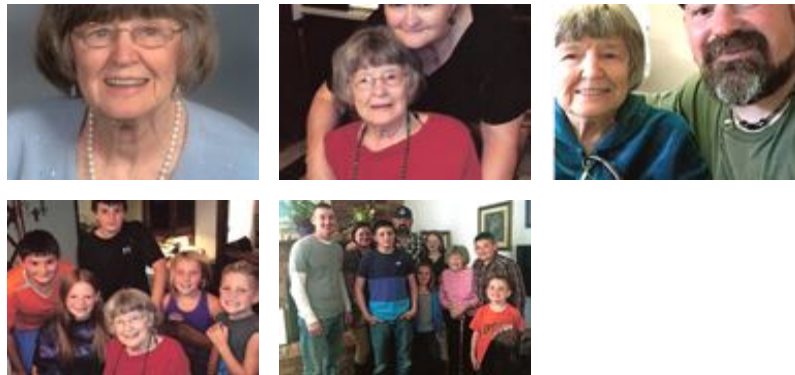
She was preceded in death by her husband Bill, brother Ralph Medlen, and two sisters, Margie Lusk and Mart Lowry.
