Beverly graduated from Pioneer High School in 1989 before heading to Oklahoma State University for her freshman year. The following year she enrolled at the University of Oklahoma where, in 1995, she earned her Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing. Throughout her college career, Beverly served her country in the Army Reserves.

After graduation, Beverly traveled the United States as a traveling Nurse for ten years, a wound care nurse specializing in Hyperbaric Medicine for six years, before pursuing her Masters of Nursing at the University of Cincinnati, Ohio.
