



Billy Joe Ging

June 1, 1943 - July 5, 2013

The funeral service for Billy Joe Ging, age 70, will be at 10:00 AM Wednesday, July 10, 2013, at Cedar Ridge Wesleyan Church, with Pastor Ron Olson officiating. Burial will follow in Memorial Park Cemetery. Visitation for family and friends will be Tuesday evening 5:30 to 7:00 PM at Anderson-Burriss Funeral Home. Billy was born to Joe Henry and Eunice (Razey) Ging on June 1, 1943, in Granite, and died Friday, July 5, 2013, at Kaw Lake. Billy grew up in Carmen and Enid, graduating from Enid High School.
