



## Bobby "Bob" Gene McGuffee

The funeral service for Bobby "Bob" Gene McGuffee, age 83, will be at 2:00 PM Wednesday, June 27, 2012, at Anderson-Burriss Funeral Home Chapel, with Dr. Joe Wilson and Rev. Eric Keller officiating.
