Bradley Sean Wright passed away unexpectedly on May 2, 2020 in Palm Springs, CA at the age of 54. He was born on February 4, 1966 to Merland and Connie (Mauck) Wright. His remains are to be interred at Memorial Park Cemetery, Enid, OK in a private family graveside service.

Brad attended elementary school in Enid, OK through the 5th grade and finished out his secondary education in the Kremlin - Hillsdale School system graduating in 1984. After high school Brad attended Central State University, Edmond, OK. While at CSU he was a member of the Kaleidoscope Dancers and performed one summer at Tsa-La-Gi Amphitheater near Tahlequah, OK. In 1986 Brad moved to the Kansas City area. He worked for the Convention And Visitors Bureau Of Greater Kansas City as Housing Coordinator, Hallmark Cards and Investors Fiduciary Trust Company in the H/R Dept.

Kaitlyn Wright, nephew Jacob Wright and 5 cousins. Brad leaves behind his very special loving furry companion, Misty.

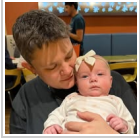
