In 1975 he opened and began operating Cecil's Jewelry. He loved to work and enjoyed spending time at the shop. Cecil was a hard worker and a loving husband, father, and grandfather.

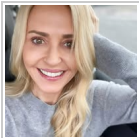

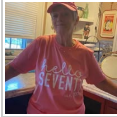
