Bragg, North Carolina, then he went to Long Binh Post in Vietnam in 1968. Chuck was discharged at Ft. Sill, Oklahoma in 1968.

He was employed at St. Mary's Hospital in 1968 as the credit manager until 1974 when he was promoted to office manager until 1982. He also served as Hospital Administrator reopening E.P. Clapper Memorial Hospital in Waynoka, Oklahoma in 1975 and 1976. He then worked for a short time in wholesale electronics and then was employed with the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center, Enid Family Medicine Clinic as Clinic Manager from 1984 to 2005.

Chuck enjoyed family, fishing, hunting, woodworking and golf. He was an avid "Corvette'r" and loved all kinds of cars. He was active in the Central Christian Church as a deacon and elder serving on various committees and ministries. He loved his Lord and attended the "Walk to Emmaus".
