several times. He was a member of Dudes and Dolls Square Dancing Club and was a great pitch player.

Charley was preceded in death by his parents; brothers, George and Andrew; sisters, Margaret and Thelma and two infant sisters.

He is survived by his wife, Dee; four children and their spouses, Keith and Deana Cunningham, Kyle and Judi Cunningham, Kara and Tim Hopkins, and Kimberly and Darrell Clark; fifteen grandchildren, and nine great grandchildren; two brothers, Earl and Calvin Cunningham; two sisters, Laverna Selix and Diana Kay Clary; nieces, nephews, and many friends.
