Dorothy was born to Ferdinand and Sophia (Bazman) Chrapkowski on May 16, 1927, in Boelus, Nebraska, and died Thursday, August 23, 2012, in Enid. Dorothy grew up in Grand Island, Nebraska. On September 6, 1948, she married Donald Hughes. They moved to Enid in 1957, where she was a homemaker and mother. Dorothy later worked at Newman's Department Store. She was a chaplain at St. Mary's Hospital from 1988 - 1995. Dorothy was a member of St. Gregory Church, Goodtimers Band, Catholic Women's Study Club, Mary Magdalene Study Club, Beta Sigma Phi Sorority, Knights of Columbus Auxiliary, RSVP, and #1 Polka Club.
