He graduated from Fox High School in 1962 and attended Tulsa Welding Institute in 1963. In 1982, he returned to Tulsa Welding School to get his welding certification for the state of Oklahoma. In 1990-1992, he attended Autry Tech to obtain his airframe and power plant certification. He was a self-employed welder for most of his life. He was also employed as a detention officer for Garfield County Sherriff's Department retiring in 2012.
