



Flossie Jean Merrill

The funeral for Flossie Merrill, age 86, of Enid, will be at 10:00 AM Tuesday, February 28, 2017, at Cedar Ridge Wesleyan Church, with Pastor Ron Olson officiating. Burial will follow in Memorial Park Cemetery, with arrangements by Anderson-Burriss Funeral Home.

Flossie was born August 27, 1930 to Everette and Rena (Crawford) Coulter in McWillie, Oklahoma,, and met her Heavenly Father on February 25, 2017 in Enid.
