



## Frances Cook Sullivan

December 4, 1921 - March 24, 2012

The funeral service for Frances (Cook) Sullivan, age 90, will be at 2:00 P.M. Wednesday, March 28, 2012, at First Baptist Church in Nash, with Rev. Sam Farris, Rev. Dan O'Daniel, and Rev. James Rowton officiating. Burial will be in New Home Cemetery in Nash, with arrangements by Anderson-Burris Funeral Home. Visitation with family will be Tuesday evening 6:00 to 7:30 PM at the funeral home. Frances was born to Edgar and May (Summers) Cook on December 4, 1921, in Lodge Pole, Nebraska, and died Saturday, March 24, 2012, in Enid. Frances graduated from Pond Creek High School in 1940. She accepted Christ as Savior in McPherson, Kansas at the age of nineteen. On July 31, 1946, she married J.C. Sullivan in Enid. Frances was a long-standing member of Eagle Grove Assembly of God Church in Nash. She was a dedicated Christian and peacemaker, who lived to serve others.
