



## Geneve L. "Jenny" McLane

March 24, 1947 - January 7, 2017

Jenny was born to Kenneth Eugene and Elinor Elizabeth (Brockhaus) Hubbs, on March 24, 1947 in Oklahoma City, and passed away on Saturday, January 7, 2017 in Dallas, Texas.
