



James "Jim" Lichtenberg

June 23, 1938 - November 26, 2018

Funeral service for Jim Lichtenberg, 80, of Enid, will be 2:00 PM, Thursday, November 29, 2018 at St. Paul's Lutheran Church with Pastor David Reber, Jr. officiating.
