



Jeffrey Scott Shaffer

Funeral service for Jeffrey Scott Shaffer, 63, will be Monday, June 15, 2026, at 10:00 am in World Harvest Church with Pastor Brad Mendenhall officiating. Burial will be at 3:00 pm in the Gate Cemetery, Gate, Oklahoma under the direction of Anderson-Burriss Funeral Home and Crematory. Visitation with the family will be on Saturday from 3:00 pm to 4:00 pm at the funeral home.

Jeffrey Scott Shaffer was born on November 11, 1962, in Stillwater, Oklahoma, foreshadowing his loyal and true status of being an Oklahoma State fan. He was born to Rod and Bonnie Shaffer and the young family soon moved to Arkansas, following Rod's Air Force career. In 1969, the family moved to the Shaffer family homestead near Rosston and continue the family tradition of farming and ranching in Northwest Oklahoma. Jeff spent his formative years working and playing on the family ranch.

Jeff graduated from Laverne High School in 1981. He later met and married Lucinda Covalt in Woodward, in 1990. Jeff and Lucinda had two daughters (Mariah and Madison), while living in Woodward. The family moved to Enid in 1997, where the family expanded to include two sons (Jadon and Jace). Although Jeff and Lucinda divorced in 2003, they remained close friends and continued raising their children together.

After moving to Enid, Jeff began a long and distinguished career as a realtor.

During his real estate career, Jeff served as president of the National Association of Realtors, president of the Oklahoma Association of Realtors, board president of the Northwest Oklahoma Association of Realtors, and served on numerous other committees and boards. Jeff was named Oklahoma Realtor of the Year in 2011. He also wrote and co-wrote several real estate related legislative bills that later became Oklahoma laws. Jeff spent 24 years working at Coldwell Bank Realty III in Enid, where he also managed the office and mentored numerous young realtors. They were truly his second family.

Jeff spent most of his life trying to serve and walk like Christ. He was consistently active in his church in various leadership positions and organized numerous youth related activities. He truly cared about helping others, especially those in need, and was known for his generous nature. People commonly came to Jeff, when they were in need of advice. Jeff was a fun loving and adventurous man who was beloved by everyone who met him. The stories he told were usually followed by the common phrase "Oh Jeffery....."

Jeff was preceded in death by his parents, Rod & Bonnie Shaffer; brother, Jason Shaffer; nephew, Bryce Shaffer; grandsons, Barrett Sierra and Titus Kennedy.

Jeff is survived by his children, Mariah Bruno (Fank), Madison Shaffer, Jadon Shaffer (Chase), and Jace Shaffer (Corrinne); granddaughter, Aspen Padilla; brother, Jim Shaffer (Lana); niece, Kensli Shaffer. Along with numerous aunts, uncles, cousins, and friends who he considered family.
