



## Johnnie Mae McCrate

February 23, 1931 - January 26, 2022

Johnnie was born February 23, 1931 in Amarillo, Texas to John and Ada Simmons Young and died January 26, 2022 in Tulsa, Oklahoma.

She grew up in Pampa, Texas and graduated from Pampa High School. On June 12, 1949, she married Phil McCrate in Pampa, where they made their home. They moved to Elk City, Glendive, Montana, and then Seiling following Phil's job with Shell Oil Company. They moved to Enid in 1995. Johnnie had a custom drapery business for many years. She was active in Elk City Assembly of God Church, Seiling Assembly of God, and later Enid First Assembly, serving as Sunday school teacher for over 20 years. They volunteered with MAPS, which is a volunteer team of RV'ers, working all over the country building churches and assisting with other building projects.

Johnnie was preceded in death by her husband, Phil; daughter, Susan Thiessen; brothers, Dean and JD Young; sister, Myrtle Briles.

She is survived by her sons and their wives, Mike and Wanda McCrate and Jim and Sharon McCrate; 8 grandchildren and 25 great grandchildren; other relatives and friends.
