



## Juanita "Joyce" LeGrand

August 5, 1941 - July 28, 2023

Celebration of Life Service for Joyce LeGrand, 81 of Garber, will be 2:00 p.m. Tuesday, August 1, 2023, in the First Baptist Church of Garber with Tom LeGrand officiating. Joyce was born August 5, 1941, at Ponca City to Homer and Bessie Dollarhide Sloan and passed away Friday, July 28, 2023, in Enid.

After retiring in 2005 they moved out to a farm in Fairmont, before later moving to Garber in 2014. She devotedly attended churches in Ponca City, Craig, Colorado, Enid, and Garber, where she played the piano and led Sunday school classes. Joyce loved the Lord, people, playing the piano, singing, and her family. She used her talents as a piano player and singer to join the Singing Church Women for several years touring across the country to perform. She was a beacon of light and hope to all who knew her, each with

their own story of how she was a “mother”, “grandma”, “counselor”, or “closest friend” to them. Her sweet spirit ministered to so many, and she will be sorely missed by all who knew her.

Joyce was preceded in death by her husband (Tom), two brothers (Bobby, William), sister (Betty) and a grandson (William). She is survived by her children, Tracy LeGrand (Donna), Teresa LeGrand, and Tom LeGrand, six grandchildren (Mikki (Raymond), Mikayla (Colby), Noah, Elizabeth (Joshua), Michael, Salena) six great-grandchildren (RaeLynn, Aria, Olivia, Landon, Ethan, Chase), and a brother (Arnold Sloan).
