Funeral services for Lanora Donahoo, 78, of Enid, will be Wednesday, February 11, 2015 at 10:00 A.M. at First United Methodist Church. Burial will be in Stafford Cemetery near Clinton under the direction of Anderson-Burriss Funeral Home. Visitation with the family will be Tuesday evening from 6:00 until 7:30 at the funeral home. Lanora was born to Emery and Edna (Cook) Miller on April 14, 1936, in Arapaho, and passed away Friday, February 6, 2015, in Enid. Lanora grew up in Arapaho, where she graduated High School in 1954. She attended Oklahoma State University, then named Oklahoma A & M, and received her Bachelor of Science degree in May 1958 in Vocational Home Economics Education. On December 27, 1958, Lanora married Donnie Donahoo in Arapaho, and they made their home in Hooker, Oklahoma, where she taught home economics. In 1959, Lanora began working for the Oklahoma Cooperative Extension Service at Cheyenne, Oklahoma, in Roger Mills County. Don and Lanora moved to Enid in 1974 and after several years of raising a family, Lanora decided to return to college and received her Master of Science degree in Home Economics Education and Community Service from Oklahoma State in 1986. She was a member of First United Methodist Church, Bethany Oklahoma Home & Community Education, Enid Noon Lions Club, and recently joined North Enid Lions Club. Lanora was a long-time Garfield County 4-H volunteer. She is survived by son Randall Donahoo of Stillwater; daughter Tracy Lane of Claremore; three grandchildren; and brother Jesse H. Miller of Byars, Oklahoma. Lanora is
