Laroy was born December 6, 1923, in Hennessey, to Vernon Laroy and Elsie Mae (Summers) Goodpasture, and passed away on Saturday, October 15, 2016 in Enid.

Laroy graduated from Hennessey High School, and served in the United States Army during WWII, at the 1st HQ hospital unit. On April 6, 1947, he married Beatrice Mae Patocka in Winfield, Kansas. He was a meat cutter for over 40 years at Safeway.
