Funeral services for Margie Ellen Postier, 76 of Enid, will be Monday, April 1, 2019 at 2:00 p.m. in Redeemer Lutheran Church with Pastor Dwayne Schroeder officiating. Margie was born on August 17, 1942 in Enid to Arthur and Laura Schweer Heim and died on March 29, 2019 in Enid.

She grew up in Fairmont and attended Zion Lutheran School through the eighth grade. Margie graduated from Garber High School in 1960. On February 11, 1961, she married John Postier in the Immanuel Lutheran Church, Garber. They made their home in Enid, then Edmond before returning to Enid. Margie began her career as the secretary for the Garfield County Commissioners in 1973, retiring after 34 years of service. She was an active member of Redeemer Lutheran Church, where she was involved with the Seasoned Saints, ladies auxiliary, and serving funeral dinners. Margie loved spending time with her family.
