Mary Kathleen "Kathy" Langham was born on January 30, 1954 in Hobbs, New Mexico to Donald J. and Margaret Merrick Langham and passed to her heavenly home in Enid on Friday, October 13, 2023 at the age of 69 years. Kathy was the only girl in a family with three brothers. Don worked for Phillips Petroleum and the family moved to Borger, Texas and ultimately Aetna, Kansas in 1970. Kathy graduated from Hardtner High School in 1972 and married Rocky Grant in Wichita, Kansas in 1973. They raised three sons, Brandon, Bryan and Chris in Hardtner. Once the boys were older, Kathy entered college at Northwestern Oklahoma State University in Alva and graduated in 1999. The family moved to Enid and Kathy started her teaching career at Pioneer Schools.
