Mary Kathrine was born November 28, 1939, to Andrew and Emma Lee Brown in Enid, Oklahoma, and passed away Monday, July 11, 2016, at her home in Enid. Her home-going celebration service will be at 1:00 P.M. Monday, July 18, 2016, at First Missionary Baptist Church.
