Nancy Mae Donnelley, Midwest City, Oklahoma, took the hand of Our Lord Jesus Christ and stepped into eternity on June 15, 2021. Born in Washington D.C. on January 9, 1934, to Della Kaiser, Nancy walked past the White House every day on her way to school and work, and she was proud of her service as a candy striper at Walter Reed Medical Center.

Nancy brought beauty and a creative vision to all of her endeavors; she was especially gifted at transforming spaces and events. Nancy put her creative flair for flower arranging and decorating to use as the owner and operator of Toby's Bridal shop in Midwest City. Her love of colors, fabrics, home interiors, and art were beautifully displayed in her homes (Midwest City and Enid), where she often hosted large family gatherings, entertaining guests with a rotating repertoire of funny family anecdotes.

Nancy and Stan moved from Midwest City to Enid, Oklahoma in 1982. There, she was a member of the Saint Francis Xavier Catholic Church, an Acolyte, a member of the Ladies Altar Society, and the church's wedding coordinator. Nancy also served on the Archdiocesan Council of Catholic Women at the state and national levels.
