



Phil McCrate

June 7, 1927 - May 10, 2015

The funeral service for Phil McCrate, age 87, will be at 10:00 A.M. Thursday, May 14, 2015, at Enid First Assembly of God Church, with Pastor Dan Barrick and grandson Rev. Bryan Thiessen officiating. Burial will follow in Memorial Park Cemetery, with arrangements by Anderson-Burriss Funeral Home. Visitation with family will be Wednesday evening 5:30 to 7:00 PM at the funeral home. Phil was born to William and Mary (Taber) McCrate on June 7, 1927, in Shattuck, and passed away Sunday, May 10, 2015, in Oklahoma City. Phil grew up in Pampa and graduated from high school there. Phil served in the U.S. Navy during World War II. On June 12, 1949, he married Johnnie Mae Young in Pampa, and they made their home there. Phil worked for Shell Oil Company, and was transferred to Elk City, Glendive, Montana, and then Seiling, where he retired. Phil and Johnnie moved to Enid in 1995. Phil was an active member of Elk City Assembly of God Church and then later Enid First Assembly, serving as both deacon and Secretary-Treasurer. Phil and Johnnie were volunteers with MAPS, which is a volunteer team of RV'ers, working all over the country building churches and assisting with other building projects. Phil was an excellent woodcarver, making many beautiful wood pieces for friends and family. Phil is survived by his wife Johnnie; two sons, Mike and Wanda McCrate of Claremore, Jim and wife Sharon McCrate of Yukon; with grandchildren: Alicia, Tim, Amy, Travis, Jeremy, Jacklyn, Josh and Bryan; and 21 great-grandchildren.
