Robert Eugene DeBoard of Allen, Texas went to be with the Lord on October 31, 2015 at the age of 82. He was born June 30, 1933 to Jesse Paul and Sadie Johanna (Weber) DeBoard in Covington. Robert graduated from Covington High School in 1951 and Enid Business College with a Business Administration Degree in 1952.
