Robert Charles Hoffman died on June 25, 2026 in Enid, Oklahoma. He was known as Bob, Doc, Hoff, and Dad by the people who knew and loved him. He was born July 14, 1938, in Winfield, Kansas, to August W. and Clara (Schmidt) Hoffman. Bob graduated from Newkirk High School, Newkirk, Oklahoma, in 1957. He attended Oklahoma State University and graduated in 1960. Bob went on to medical school at the University of Oklahoma. He completed his residency in Albuquerque, New Mexico, specializing in urology and helped establish Enid Urology and Associated in Enid, Oklahoma. He and Mary Jo Schaefer were married on June 28, 1963. They later divorced. He married Lisa O'Neill on January 17, 2009.
