



## Robert "Bob" Hayes

November 2, 1925 - October 18, 2013

The funeral for Robert "Bob" Lee Hayes, age 87, of Park Hill, formerly of Enid, will be at 2:00 PM Wednesday, October 23, 2013, at Central Assembly of God Church, with Pastor Kevin Ward officiating.
