



## Roberta I. Comer

Roberta went to work at Marquise Studio in 1941. On August 30, 1944, she married E.S. Comer in Enid. They lived in Virginia, where he was a Marine stationed at Quantico. Roberta worked as an assistant photographer at Ft. Belvoir, Virginia. After moving back to Enid, she worked at Marquise Studio again until 1968. Roberta later went to night school and earned her GED. In 1966, she took the Home Health Aid Course and took care of her mother until she passed away. Roberta continued to work in home health care for twelve years. She was blessed to have her family close, and her favorite hobby was cooking, especially cookies and candy. She was a member of Enid First Assembly of God Church. Roberta was preceded in death by her husband in 1991, one brother, and two sisters.
