



## Rosa May Patocka

May 31, 1934 - January 13, 2017

Mass of Christian Burial for Rosa M. Patocka, age 82, of Enid, will be Wednesday, January 18, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. in St. Francis Xavier Catholic Church with Rev Joseph Irwin and Rev. Aaron Foshee as celebrant. Recitation of the Rosary will be Tuesday evening, January 17 at 7:00 p.m., followed by visitation at Anderson-Burriss Funeral Home. Rosa was born to William and Rhoda (May) Rolison on May 31, 1934, in Clinton, Oklahoma, and passed away on Friday, January 13, 2017 in Enid.

Rosa grew up in the Clinton area, graduated from Clinton High School, and attended SWOSU in Weatherford. On October 11, 1955, she married Willard Patocka in Hennessey. 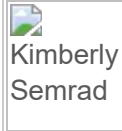
