FFA American Farmer recipient. Steve enjoyed showing livestock in his younger years, and then instilled that love in his children, nieces, nephews and his grandson. Steve was an avid OU fan, and he loved his time that he spent hunting. His greatest joy was his grandson, Westin, and he loved being able to farm with his son, Chance.

Steve is survived by his parents Dick and Marilyn Simpson, of Kremlin; his wife Gay of the home; 2 children Chance Simpson of Kremlin and Sierra Simpson of Durango, Colorado; 1 grandson Westin Simpson of Enid; 2 sisters Dian Salisbury and Carolyn LaBrue both of Enid; and several nieces, nephews, cousins, and extended family.
