Dr. Theron A. Chick, 77, went home to be with his Lord Monday, August 19, 2013. He was born August 11, 1936, at the General Hospital in Enid. He attended school in Enid and graduated from Alva High School. He graduated from Northwestern State College in Alva and also had a Doctorate of Divinity from Mid-America Bible Baptist College. He married his highschool sweetheart, JoAnn Cox on August 25, 1956. They celebrated 57 wonderful years together. Dr. Chick loved his family. He loved and enjoyed his sons, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren. He loved having family gatherings. One of his favorite holidays was Christmas! He enjoyed traveling abroad. One of his favorite places to vacation was Hawaii. He also enjoyed traveling in his motor home and visiting with his friends around the country. He accepted Christ as his personal Saviour at the age of nine, and was called to preach at an early age. He said accepting Christ changed his life. He became an ordained minister on January 26, 1962. Dr. T.A. Chick was a pastor for over fifty years. He was a faithful and loving pastor at the Bible Baptist Church of Enid for 48 ½ years. As a pastor, his heart and soul was given to the ministry of the Lord Jesus Christ. His ministry was not his, but the Lord's. He always exalted the Lord Jesus Christ in his life and ministry.
