Timothy "Moose" McCoy 70, of Enid, OK, passed away peacefully at home with family on November 12th, 2025.

He was born on November 23rd, 1954, in Enid, OK to Curtis and Jane McCoy.

Tim graduated from Enid High School in 1973. He played football at Northwestern College in Alva, OK.
