Velma Lea Johnson Schultz, 92, went to her eternal heavenly home on Sunday, December 2, 2018 at Golden Oaks Nursing Home, Enid, Oklahoma. Celebration of Life Services will be held at 10:00 a.m., Thursday, December 6, 2018 at Anderson-Burriss Funeral Home Chapel, officiated by Rev. Alan Seibel. In 1947, she met Chester Schultz of Hitchcock, Oklahoma and they were married December 27, 1947. They were married 53 years and were blessed with four children, Stanley, Suzanne, Diane, and Richard. Velma truly was the matriarch of the family and a source of strength for all of us. She loved family gatherings and sharing in people's lives. She worked side-by-side with Chester on the family farm, and later worked twenty years as the manager of the college bookstore at Phillips University. Her heart's desire was to leave a legacy of a faithful life in Christ.
