Virgil L. Streck, of Enid, went home to be with his Lord on Wednesday, February 6, 2013, at the age of 102. He was born June 14, 1910 in Carrier to Jake and Helen Weibel (Weber) Streck. Virgil married Eleanor Bowman Masemore in 1935, and they had five children. Virgil was a self-taught mechanic and taught airplane mechanics at Vance AFB. He had a mechanic shop at his home as well. He was a farmer, rancher, and pilot who flew his own two planes, one of which he built himself. Virgil was a member of Hillsdale Bible Church. Virgil and Eleanor moved off the farm to Enid in 1984. After Eleanor's passing in 2001, Virgil moved to the Commons at The Methodist Home in Enid.
