



Vivian Caroline Musser

A Mass of Christian Burial for Vivian Caroline Musser, age 92, will be at 10:00 AM Thursday, December 20, 2012, at St. Gregory the Great Catholic Church, with Rev. Joseph Irwin officiating. Vivian was born to Marcellin and Carrie (Paishon) Pereira on December 14, 1920, in Honolulu, Hawaii, and died Tuesday, December 18, 2012, at The Commons in Enid. Vivian graduated from McKinley High School in Honolulu and St. Francis Hospital School of Nursing with her RN, and Incarnate Word College with her BSN. On February 10, 1956, she married John Musser. Vivian was the first public health nurse in Garfield County. While living in Norman, she was nurse coordinator with Oklahoma State Nurses Association and later served in that role with Garfield County Health Department. During her career, she worked as a teaching nurse at Enid General Hospital and as a medication review nurse at Enid State School. After retiring from fulltime nursing in 1982, she continued as case manager at Eldercare. In 1991, she became coordinator at Garfield County Senior Citizens Center, retiring in the summer of 1995. Vivian volunteered at Bass, where she gave more than 1950 hours of service. She is survived by children Marcia Musser of Norman, Carolyn and Bob Holden of Enid, Mark and Julie Musser of Colleyville, Texas; five grandchildren, Christen Rogers, Caleb Holden, Jessica Musser, Elliott Holden, and Matthew Musser; two great grandchildren, Calista Rogers and Tabor Runser; and two sisters, Mary Tavares of North Carolina and Shirley Caires of California.
