



Wilbur E. Johnson

Funeral services for Wilbur E. Johnson, age 83 of Enid, will be at 1:00 PM Tuesday, August 8, 2017, in the Anderson-Burriss Funeral Home Chapel with Pastor Len Coulter officiating. He farmed all of his life until 2009.
